We're on a mission to save the planet by collecting, washing, and reusing wine bottles.

Here's the Problem:

- → The United States is the only industrialized country without a nationwide return and reuse glass bottle system.
- → **16.2 billion** glass bottles and containers are consumed annually. Less than **30%** of those are actually recycled.
- → U.S. production of glass bottles has always been below industry demands, causing a reliance on imports and fluctuations due to global pressures.
- \rightarrow A single glass wine bottle generates an estimated 1.28 kg of CO2, which is more than the wine itself!

Here's the Solution:

Meet Revino

Revino provides wine bottle reclamation and sanitation services to wine producers while building a robust local and sustainable glass supply network. Our process operates in an infinite loop starting with bottle manufacturing and distribution, moving to consumption and redemption, and ending with bottle sanitization and reuse.

We're setting up shop in wine regions across the west coast. But our plans for expansion match the size of the problem we face in this single-use glass bottle ecosystem – BIG! Look for us in your region and keep an eye out as we expand our services to support beer, kombucha, and other beverage producers in the future.
